Good Morning Mr. Bowling,

First, thank you for providing me the opportunity with being able to submit a proposal to the Committee.

I wanted to present an idea about being able to streamline daycare issues across the DOD similar to on-base lodging, (i.e. If a military member were to go TAD/TDY to another installation).

In this idea, it would be presented for a family/parent PCS'ing to a new duty station and wanted a childcare option on base. If that installation childcare didn't have any availabilities, the military member would receive a letter of Non-Availability.

This letter would serve for off-base purposes:

- A document that would present particular price ranges (low-high) for that military member when looking for off base daycare within particular zip codes.
- Would automatically approve them for CYP/NACCRA at a faster rate.

Another course of action IRT streamlining on-base daycare issues, would be sponsoring courses for spouses to get certified with running/opening new daycares.

Having these certification/class opportunities available on base installations (ie. Sponsored by MCCS).
