

- b. 1/c and 2/c cadets are authorized to wear appropriate civilian clothing during regular liberty or authorized special liberty. Cadets must not loiter in the barracks in civilian attire.
- c. 3/c cadets are authorized to wear the Uniform of the Day or the issued recreation gear on liberty when authorized by the Assistant Commandant of Cadets or Commandant of Cadets.
  - (1) Issued Recreational Gear Uniform. The uniform will consist of the navy blue, grey or light blue polo shirt issued by the Cadet Bookstore with the "CGA" crest on the left breast and the navy blue v-neck sweater. Only the uppermost button may be unbuttoned, and the shirt must be tucked in at all times for males and untucked for females. Pants will be the khaki-colored chino pants issued by the Cadet Bookstore. Females may wear a knee length khaki-colored skirt (requires approval from the Golf Company Officer). The issued brown belt must be worn with pants at all times. The issued brown sailing shoe and white socks may be worn year-round. Approved alternatives to the sailing shoe will be made available for purchase through the Cadet Bookstore. During winter months and inclement weather, cadets may wear the issued boot. Pant legs will be pulled over the boot as to expose as little boot as possible.
  - (2) In the summer, the pants may be replaced by the khaki shorts issued by the bookstore or the optional skirt for females that has been approved by the Golf Company Officer. The belt must be worn at all times with the shorts.
  - (3) The outwear for this uniform will be the foul weather parka II without class insignia. The ODU Utility Jacket (foul weather parka II fitted blue power shield liner) without class insignia is authorized as a stand-alone jacket. Wearing the fleece as a stand-alone garment is not allowed. From November 1<sup>st</sup> to April 1<sup>st</sup>, the parka will be an optional item over the polo shirt. Sweatshirts are not authorized to be worn with the casual liberty attire.
  - (4) Females are authorized to carry a leather purse. The purse must be plain, unadorned, black or brown leather or synthetic material, envelope style not more than 12 inches wide, 8 inches high and 5 inches deep. It may have a detachable shoulder strap and may be used with or without the strap.
  - (5) Cadets may wear jewelry with the Recreational Gear Uniform. However the jewelry must be in accordance with 13.a of this Chapter.
  - (6) Female cadets are authorized to wear their hair down or in a ponytail. Female hair accessories must be conservative in nature and in a color that closely matches the color of the member's hair or be solid black or brown in color.
  - (7) Baseball caps or any other form of headgear are strictly forbidden.
