Standardized Navy CDH Subsidies

- Fair Market Value Based on U.S. Market Rates
 - Separate High Cost Areas
 - Recruitment/Retention Incentives Built In
- Age Group Differential Infants vs. Preschoolers
- Curriculum License and Supplies
- Lending Library (Equipment/Toys)
- National Accreditation Incentives
 - DoD Certification Required Accreditation is Optional
- Need Based Incentives
 - Extended Care (shift work, evening care, holidays, weekend duty)
 - Under the Age of 3 Only Homes (compensation for less children)
 - Special Needs Children
 - Care for Ombudsman Children while Performing Official Duties
 - Wounded Warriors in Treatment
 - Respite Care
 - Parent Fee Credit Card Offset
