The Committee requests briefings from the Military Services* on the application of the FCP Policy in each respective Service branch and how the appropriate application of the FCP is verified down to the unit level?

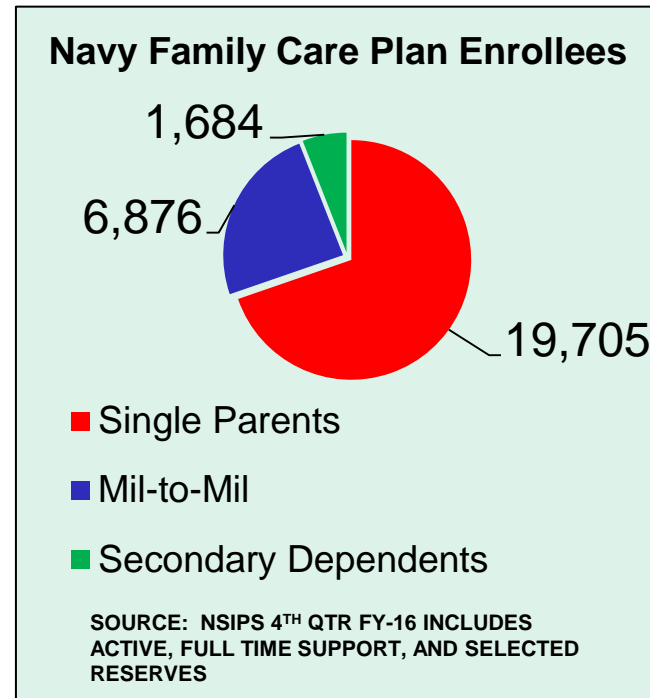
- **Navy Family Care Plan (FCP) program:**
 - Command administered under OPNAVINST 1740.4D
 - Single parents, military married to military with dependents, and military members with secondary dependents (e.g., parents) unable to take care of themselves are required to have a FCP
 - A mission planning tool to ensure family members/dependents are cared for during *foreseeable* absences including:
 - Short term (temporary additional duty (TAD), training exercises, annual training)
 - Long term (deployments, unaccompanied tours, recall)
 - Other at discretion of Commanding Officer (extended working hours, weekend duty, watches)

The Committee requests briefings from the Military Services* on the application of the FCP Policy in each respective Service branch and how the appropriate application of the FCP is verified down to the unit level?

- **Administration of Navy Family Care Plan via Navy Standard Integrated Personnel System (NSIPS):**
 - Streamlined certification process
 - Data collect collection
 - Generic email for feedback from Sailors and commands (navy.familycareplan@navy.mil)
- **NSIPS will send a notification email to the Service member if a FCP is required or if it is due for recertification:**
 - Based upon the information of dependency on the Service members record of emergency data

The Committee requests briefings from the Military Services* on the application of the FCP Policy in each respective Service branch and how the appropriate application of the FCP is verified down to the unit level?

- **Commands and the Family Care Plan:**
 - NSIPS reports verify who is required to have a FCP, and if the FCP is current and valid
 - Designated FCP coordinators act as the commander's representative in managing the FCP program
 - FCP is part of the Command Master Chief/Chief of the Boat personal qualification standard
 - The FCP program is reviewed through the Inspector General's inspection process at all Navy Echelon 2 and 3 commands
