U.S. AIR FORCE

- **5a. Current and new initiatives to expand childcare support to Service members (e.g., 24/7 facilities).**
 - **Significant budget increase FY19-23**
 - **Implemented human capital strategies to enhance hiring and retention of qualified staff**
 - **Deployed initiatives to increase number of Family Child Care providers to expand child care capacity**
 - **Expanded community child care options for families assigned overseas (not near a U.S. military installation)**
 - **Enhanced the Expanded Child Care Program**
 - **Partnered with Installation Mission Support Center on facility shortfalls**

- **5b. Current and new initiatives to increase awareness of childcare options and resources.**
 - **MilitaryChildCare.com**
 - **“FCC and Your Family” Booklet**
 - **Expanded role of Family Child Care (FCC) Coordinators to Community Child Care Coordinators**
 - **Installation primary point of contact for information about military and civilian child care services**
 - **Builds community partnerships and networks to maximize availability of child care**
 - **Consults with commanders, unit leadership, and families on community resources**
 - **Educates families on child care subsidy options**

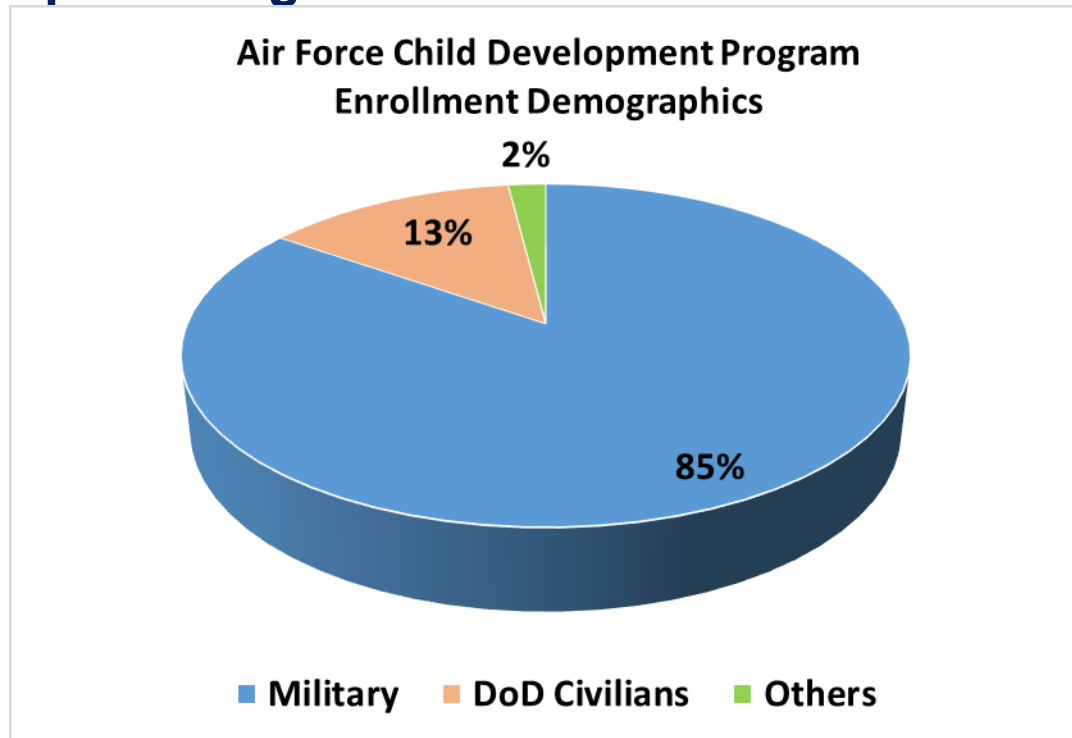
- **5c. Current or pending policies to enforce Child Development Center (CDC) priorities via revalidation of enrolled children vice those with a higher priority on the waiting list.**
 - **Waiting list priorities are established in accordance with DoD Instruction (DoDI) 6060.02, "Child Development Programs (CDPs)"**
 - **Space available patrons are notified at time of enrollment their space must be vacated if a higher priority patron requires child care**
 - **Parents receive 30 day written notice if their child care space is needed**
