RFI #4: Women on Ships

RFI Question:

a. What is the racks-at-sea utilization percentage for women (both officer and enlisted), as compared to their male counterparts for each class of ship that Navy personnel are assigned to?

RFI Response:

- Military personnel serve on five ship classes operated under MSC. The remainder of ships in the MSC inventory are crewed by civilian mariners or contractors.
- T-AK/T-AKR: Assigned single-occupancy staterooms irrespective of rank or gender. Current MPSRON military manning at sea is:
 - Officers: 10 Male, 2 Female
 - Enlisted: 9 Male, 1 Female
- T-AH:
 - OFFICER: Female 88%, Male 100%
 - 7 additional Officer staterooms which can be used for either male or female
 - Current makeup: 6 males, 1 female (numbers are included in total numbers)
 - ENLISTED: Female: 69%, Male 95%
- AS
 - Officer: Female 78%, Male 58%
 - Enlisted: Female 69%, Male 75%
- T-ESB
 - Officer: Female 25%, Male 50%
 - Enlisted: Female 41%, Male 53%
- LCC
 - Officer: Female 20%, Male 40%
 - Enlisted: Female 62%, Male 71%
