
SUBJECT: Delegation of Authority for Senior Reserve Officers' Training Corps (SROTC) Dependency Waivers and Exception to Policy

1. Reference: Army Regulation (AR) 145-1, Senior Reserve Officers' Training Corps Program: Organization, Administration, and Training, 22 July 1996, Rapid Action Revision (RAR) Issue Date 6 September 2011.
2. I hereby delegate to the CG, U.S. Army Cadet Command (USACC), the authority to grant the following dependency waivers IAW AR 145-1, 3-9a(1) and (3):
 - a. Married ROTC applicants who have more than three dependents, including the spouse.
 - b. Divorced or sole parent ROTC applicants who are required to pay child support.
3. Additionally, I delegate to CG, USACC, the authority to grant the following dependency exceptions to policy IAW AR 145-1, 3-9a(2), (4) and (5):
 - a. In cases where an unmarried applicant has one or more dependents under the age of 18, such as prior service or green-to-gold applicants.
 - b. In cases where the applicant has a spouse in a military component of any armed service (excluding members of the Individual Ready Reserve; those do not require waivers) who has one or more dependents under the age of 18.
 - c. In cases where a husband and wife team has one or more dependents under the age of 18.
4. Family care plans must be executable and be valid within one year of approval. The Professor of Military Science will ensure the family care plan remains current, and a copy maintained by USACC. Documentation must validate that both biological and legal parents of all children involved concur with the family care plan prior to approval. Dependency waivers and exceptions to policy will only be granted to individuals who have demonstrated responsibility and leadership skills.

5. This delegation is effective the date of this memorandum and will be incorporated in to the next AR 145-1 update.
